CAMP TIMES, DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP INFO

- **Broadway Jr. starts at 9AM, doors will open at 8:50**, if you need to drop off any earlier, you may register your child for before care at an additional charge.
- Have your child enter into the Gallery entrance facing Penn Avenue. There is a drop off lane you can use if you pull around the building. **DO NOT STOP ON PENN AVE to drop off your child!!**
- Pick-up is at 4:30 from the back door #9. Please pull into the lower parking lot. We will check out your child as they leave. No one is permitted to leave the building until their parent or "ride," is visible to the staff.

NOTES FOR EVERY DAY

- We have three weeks to put on a full production. Because of that, it is extremely important that all students arrive on time and attend every day.
- LABEL EVERYTHING
- Every day you will need
 - A lunch with a cold pack (*as needed*) that does not need refrigeration or heating
 - Filled water bottle
 - YOUR SCRIPT! and a sharpened pencil with an eraser
 - Snacks, there will be up to 2 snack/ break times a day.
- Footwear: If you own Jazz, Character and/ or Ballet shoes, then please bring them with you. Generally, wear soft soled shoes with a heel strap. **DO NOT** wear flip flops, slides, etc.

CASTING

- No roles are cast prior to the start of the program
- Participants will learn a routine and song from the show to perform as part of the audition process held officially on the first Wednesday of the camp.
- There will be two casts this year. One cast will perform Friday at 7 PM and Saturday at 3 PM, the other cast will perform Saturday at 7 PM and Sunday at 3 PM.
- Be advised, planned and/ or unplanned absence – even for illness – may affect casting or possibly result in cast changes

COSTUMES & FOOTWEAR

- Most performers will also need black jazz shoes. Your child can be sized and you can purchase them through our Dance Department or on your own.
- Because of the nature of Junie B. Jones JR we will be asking the majority of the cast to provide their costume. Cast members will meet with the costumer to go over their vision of the character and will bring a list of preferred items home with them with the date they should bring their clearly labeled items to the theater. This should not be treated as a shopping list by your performer.

SHOWTIMES & TICKETS

- Performances will be held in the Schumo Theater at the Yocum Institute for Arts Education.
- There will be two casts this year
 - **One cast will perform Friday at 7 PM and Saturday at 3 PM**
 - **One cast will perform Saturday at 7 PM and Sunday at 3 PM.**
 - You will know your child's performance date and times when casting is announced the first Wednesday evening of camp. Although we try to keep siblings in the same case, we are also looking to have a balanced show and this may not always be possible.
- All pre-purchased tickets for anyone ages 3+ are general admission for \$10 - \$15 each.
- Tickets will be sold at the Yocum Institute for Arts Education, online and in person until show day, then they will be available at the door before each show.
- Each participant will receive 2 complimentary tickets for their family and/ or friends to use for any performance as well as a personal comp so that they can attend a performance of the alternate cast.

RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHY

- The Yocum Institute will film the entire production and have DVDs and/ or Digital Download Links for sale to the cast at cost. See attached.
- Please, keep the Institute out of trouble and DO NOT photograph or record during the performances. NEVER EVER POST IMAGES ON PUBLIC WEBSITES CONNECTED TO THE SHOW
