## THE YOCUM INSTITUTE THEATER CONSERVATORY

1st Semester: Sept. 7-Dec. 20 (15 weeks)

Offered in two semesters, Conservatory is a progressive program of study for students who are interested in developing more advanced acting skills. Students will progress through the following programs during conservatory study: Yocum Players, Jr. Theater Ensemble, Teen Theater Talent Scholarship Ensemble and IMPROV! Performance Troupe. There are 5 levels of progression throughout Conservatory. Students begin at Level 1 within each area of study and continue to progress to different levels with experience and instructor approval. All levels participate in the same class with instruction being divided to attend to each level of experience while also embracing the diversity of the group. Students may start at any level in any class, there is no specific order in which the classes must be taken.

Students must either audition for conservatory classes or be recommended by a Yocum Teaching Artist. For specific audition dates, please see individual class descriptions. Nominated students are informed by letter and no audition is necessary. Students are nominated based on previous experience in Yocum Institute classes and recommendations are based on positive attitude and theatrical aptitude demonstrated in a previously taken class.

All conservatory students participate in an evening Showcase at the end of the semester on December 20 at 7 pm in Yocum's Schumo Theater.

# Dance
